

An Indian student's guide to Study in Germany

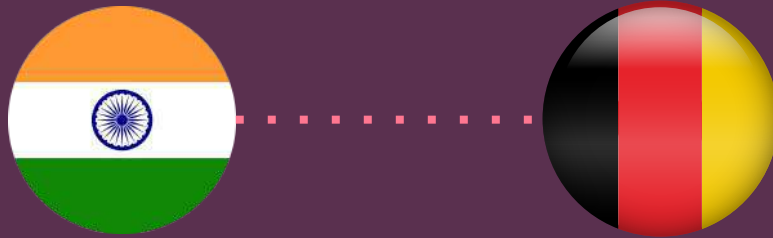


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Overview

Pathway to Permanent Residency (PR)

If you want to become a permanent resident of Germany, then you need to **apply for a Permanent Residence Permit**. These are only issued after living in Germany for a period of more than five years, and you must have had a temporary residence permit or visa for that length of time.

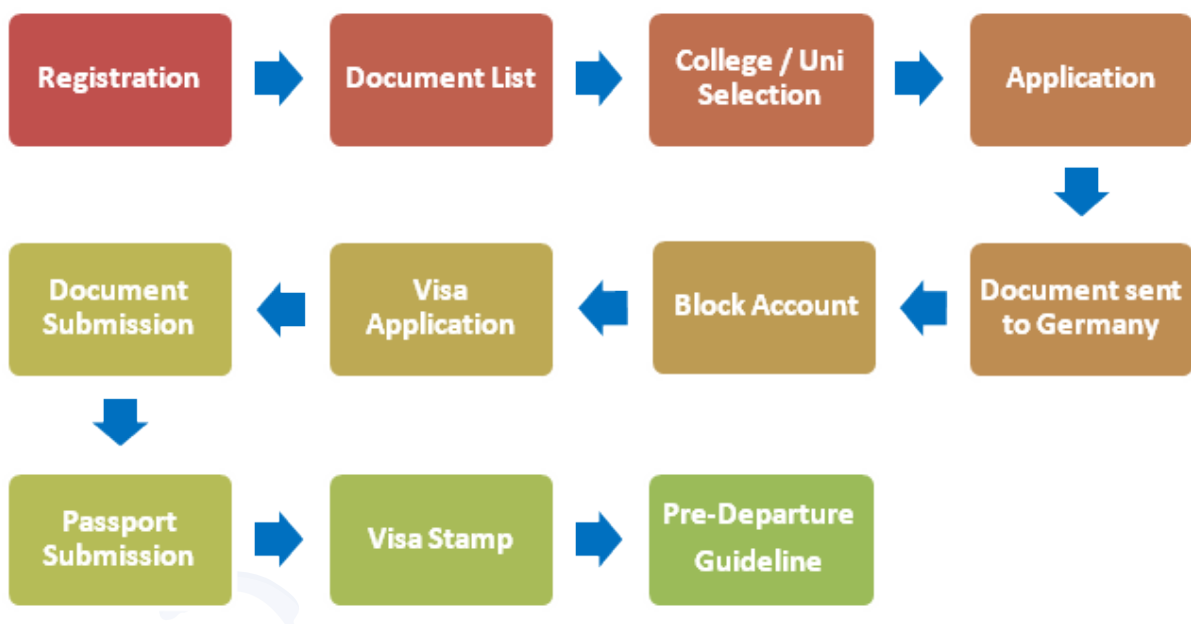


For Master

- German Language- May not always be a criteria for admission but it is better to achieve a basic level of German language A1 or A2 as more and more universities are expecting atleast A1 level proficiency apart from it being a requirement for visa as well. It is noted that candidates with German Language skills have better chance of getting admission in German Universities as compared to candidates with no German Language Skills.
- Three ways to prove the language ability is through
 1. DSH- German Language Test for Foreign Students
 2. TestDaf- Central, standardized test for German as a foreign Language
 3. ZOP of Goethe Institute
- Minimum IELTS Score—6.5+ or Minimum TOEFL Score – 87.
- Academic Percentage – Above 70% is required.
- GRE is required for good and high ranked universities—310+ is considered as good scores. GRE is a mandatory requirement for some automobiles and mechanical courses by high ranked universities.

Germany Student Visa

A German student applicant visa is the visa to apply for if you are planning to go to Germany to apply for university admission in person. This visa is initially issued for three months but can be extended for another six months upon your arrival in Germany if necessary.

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After Graduation Pathway to Permanent Residency

Apply for German settlement permit for foreign graduates of German universities. you must be a complete your education from German higher education institution. The German higher education institution can be a state, state-approved or equivalent institution of higher education.

You must have worked in Germany for at least two years after your study and your job must have matched your academic qualification received in Germany. During this time, you must have been paying your pension insurance throughout.

Finally, you must have a clean criminal record from this period. A clean criminal record means that you must not have had any recorded involvement in illegal activity.
