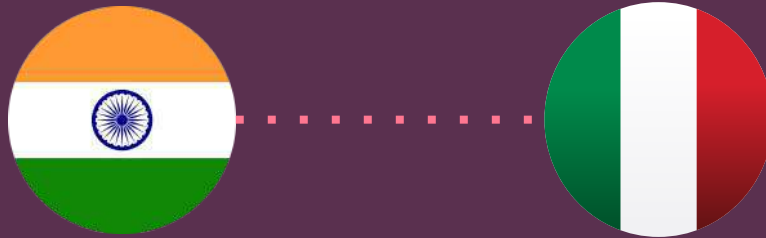

# Requirements to study in Italy

## Academic Requirements

## Scholarships

- How Can I get Scholarship in Italy after 12th ?  
One of the popular Scholarships to study in Italy for Indian students is the “Italian Government Scholarship” which is in collaboration with the Indian government. This Scholarship program is available to international students only for studying in Italy (Universities and Institutions which are based in Italy).
- What is included in Scholarship?  
**One get 100% Scholarship which covers tuition fees** for the entire degree program, **Stipend also covers hostel expenses** during the entire course duration & Stipend of rupees Minimum 9lacs for masters & rupees 13.5 lacs for Bachelors

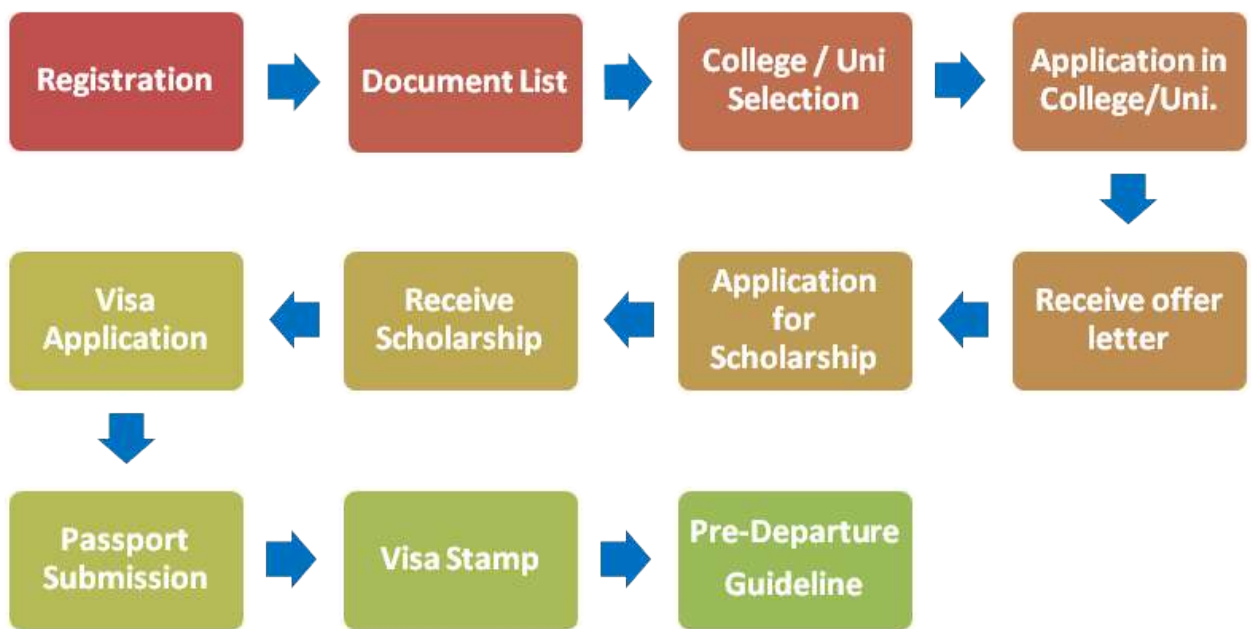
### Important Points for Scholarships

- 100% scholarship assurance for students who have received admit offer letter
- In few Universities student may get extra benefits of scholarships like food coupons.
- Scholarship is on the basis of financial documents of the student.



# Italian Student Visa

To gain entry into Italy and study there, each international student requires a study permit and student visa. You can apply for the study permit and visa once you have received an offer of admission from a Italian university/college .Hir Education offers end-to-end support to all students for the student permit and visa procedure.



## Work while studying in the Italy

Italy has extremely student-friendly work policies. Working while you're studying not only gives you an additional income, it also gives you exposure to Italian corporate life and adds to your professional growth. Students can work part-time for up to 20 hours per week during regular academic sessions, and full-time in the holidays such as summer break, Christmas holidays etc.



## After Graduation- Pathway to permanent Residency

The temporary residency visa must be obtained when first arriving in Italy by non-EU citizens. Only then can you apply for a Permanent residence permit. The student must live for a minimum period of 5 years before applying for permanent residence in Italy.

**Duration of post-Graduation work permit(PGWP) is same of 1 Year for all Students**

### What happens after the Post-Graduation Work Permit (PGWP) expires?

A job holder in Italy is eligible to apply for an extension of PGWP. The application must be done at least 90 days prior to the expiration date and the applicant must also hold a valid passport for the same. Also after the completion of PGWP, one may be eligible for Permanent Residency depending on the skills, job, and a few other factors.
